- Victims of domestic violence and/or sexual assault can call the Alaska Network on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault's Information and Referral Hotline to speak with a volunteer attorney at no charge.
- The attorney can answer your questions about many legal issues, including your legal rights, criminal law, divorce, custody, and protection orders.
- The attorney can also refer you to legal aid programs.
- You will not have to identify yourself; the hotline is anonymous.

What happens when you call?

A volunteer lawyer will answer the call. If they are on the line with someone, you may leave a message for them to call you OR you may call again later. The attorney will not ask for your name, but some demographic information will be collected for program statistics. You can talk to the attorney for as long as it takes to get your questions answered.

Note: the volunteer attorney will not be representing clients, but will instead provide legal information.
