## Inspire others, promote respect, and create a safer community for all Alaskans: an opportunity for Alaskan Men.

Nationally and in Alaska, men have expressed an interest in getting more involved in making our communities safer, in preventing sexual violence, and promoting respect in relationships.

ANDVSA, through funding from the Alaska Department of Safety, Council on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault, is offering 3-4 small grants for projects bringing together partnerships of men and community-based organization to work together to prevent domestic violence, sexual assault, and teen dating violence in their community.

Grant awards will range from \$5,000- \$10,000 and must indicate clearly the roles of each of the partners, individuals, or organizations in this project.

Projects should work to support the idea that Alaska Men *Choose and Promote Respect*.

These projects may look differently in each community and could include, but are not limited to:

- 1) Starting up a local coaching boys into men project
- 2) Incorporating healthy relationships teachable moment tools into subsistence activities or mentoring activities.
- 3) A local extension of Alaska Men Choose Respect – “your community” Men Choose Respect event, workshops, action planning, or complementary local media materials.
